



## Pattern Collection: Home



### Cabin Cover

### DIFFICULTY

Easy

### SIZES

One Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 60½"

**Width:** 60½"

### MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn Deluxe Stripes** (75% superwash wool, 25% nylon; 100g/218 yds)

- 307 Timber – 11 skeins

**Needles:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) and 16," 40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### GAUGE

14 sts x 20 rnds = 4" in Stockinette Stitch (St st) using larger ndl

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

Cozy and comfortable, the Cabin Cover is perfect for snuggling up by the fire on snowy days. Knit in easy-care Deluxe Stripes, this throw is unique and eye-catching thanks to the self-stripping effect of the yarn.

This quilt-inspired blanket is knit in individual squares that are sewn together. Each square is knit in the round from the center out. After the squares are sewn together, stitches are picked up around the outer edges of the blanket to create the garter stitch border.

## BLANKET

### Squares – Make 25

*Note: Change to circular needles when there are too many sts to fit comfortably on dpns.*

With DPNs, or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences, cast on 8 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

**Set-up Rnd:** \* K1, pm; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** [Yo, k1, yo] 4 times – 8 sts inc'd, 16 sts.

**Rnd 3:** Knit.

**Rnd 4:** [Yo, knit to m, yo] 4 times – 8 sts inc'd, 24 sts

**Rnd 5:** Knit.

Rep Rnds 4-5, 16 more times – 128 sts inc'd, 152 sts.

Loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block squares to finished measurements. Weave in ends. Sew the sides of each square together, 5 squares per row (*note: see schematic for a visual guide*).

### Right Side Border

With 40" circ ndl, RS facing, and beg at lower right edge, pick up and knit 201 sts evenly along right side of work.

**Rows 1-5:** Knit.

Bind off all sts kwise.

### Top Border

With 40" circ ndl, RS facing, and beg at upper edge of Right Side Border, pick up and knit 5 sts along Right Side Border and 201 sts along top edge of work – 206 sts.

**Rows 1-5:** Knit.

Bind off all sts kwise.

### Left Side Border

With 40" circ ndl, RS facing, and beg at left side of Top Border, pick up and knit 5 sts along Top Border and 201 sts along left side of work – 206 sts.

**Rows 1-5:** Knit.

Bind off all sts kwise.

### Bottom Border

With 40" circ ndl, RS facing, and beg of bottom of Left Side Border, pick up and knit 5 sts along Left Side Border, 201 sts along Bottom edge of work, and 5 sts along bottom edge of Right Side Border – 211 sts.

**Rows 1-5:** Knit.

Bind off all sts kwise.

Weave in rem ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>beg</b>	begin(ning)
<b>circ</b>	circular
<b>garter st</b>	knit every row
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kwise</b>	knitwise
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>yo</b>	yarn over

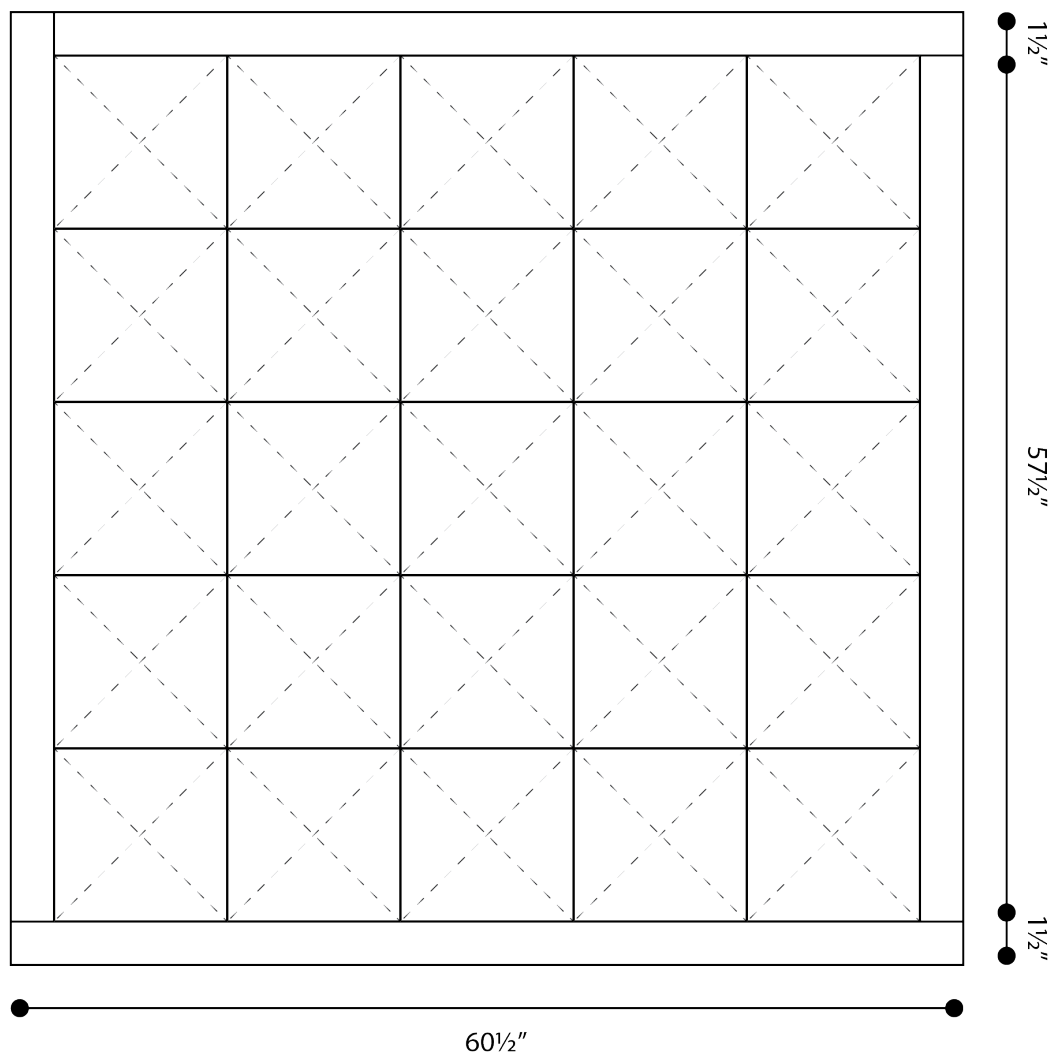

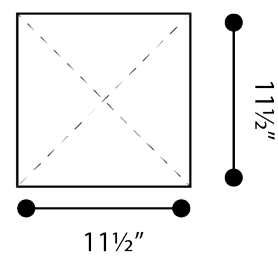
