DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Newborn (0-6 mo, 6-12 mo, 1-3 yrs)

Shown in Newborn size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 11 (13, 14, 16)
stretches to approx. 13 (15, 16, 18)"

Length: 5½ (5¾, 6, 6¼)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Dots (50% bamboo, 50% cotton; 100g/292 yds)

- 304 Watermelon Dots – 1 ball (all sizes)

Needle: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 4 (3.5 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 1½" pom pom maker

GAUGE

24 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Seed Stitch with larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.



Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Sweet as sprinkles, the Confetti Cap is the perfect spring topper for any little one in your life. Knit in Bamboo Pop, this hat is lightweight, soft, and easy to care for – making it the perfect mix of comfort and practicality. Speckles of color and double pom poms on the crown add extra fun, too!

This hat is knit in the round from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Rib

(even number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Seed Stitch

(even number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * P1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

HAT

Brim

With smaller dpns, cast on 66 (78, 84, 96) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of K1, P1 Rib to end.

Rep Rnd 1 until piece meas $\frac{3}{4}$ " from cast-on edge.

Change to larger dpns.

Hat Body

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Seed Stitch to end.

Rnd 2: Work Rnd 2 of Seed Stitch to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 until piece meas approx. $4\frac{1}{4}$ " from cast-on edge, and ending with Rnd 1 of patt.

Crown Shaping

Note: Maintain Seed Stitch as est'd throughout Crown Shaping.

Set-Up Rnd: * Cont as est'd in Seed Stitch patt over 11 (13, 14, 16) sts, pm; rep from * to end – 6 markers placed over rnd.

Rnd 1: * Ssk, cont as est'd to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 12 sts dec'd, 54 (66, 72, 84) sts rem.

Rnd 2: * K1, cont as est'd to 1 st bef m, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 3 (4, 4, 5) more times – 36 (48, 48, 60) sts dec'd, 18 (18, 24, 24) sts rem.

6-12 mo and 1-3 yr Sizes ONLY:

Next Rnd: * Ssk, k1; rep from * to end – 6 sts dec'd, 18 (18) sts rem.

Next Rnd: * Knit.

All Sizes

18 sts.

Break yarn leaving 8" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends. Using pom pom maker, make two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pom poms and secure to either side of center-top of hat, leaving approx 2-3" between pom poms. To achieve a fluffy effect on the pom poms as pictured, we recommend brushing over them with a fine-tooth comb, opening up the plies of the yarn.

k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern

rep	repeat
rnd	round
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)

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
