#### Sprinkle Mittens

#### SKILL

Knitting

#### DIFFICULTY

Easy

#### SIZES

Adult Small/Medium (Medium/Large)  
*Shown in Adult Medium/Large size.*

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hand Circumference: 7¼ (8)"

Length: 9½ (10¼)"

#### MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn Uptown Bamboo DK** (80% anti-pilling acrylic, 20% bamboo; 100g/284 yds)

- 506 Apricot (MC) – 1 skein

**Universal Yarn Bella Pom Pom** (78% polyamide, 22% polyester; 100g/334 yds)

- 101 Neon Fun (CC) – 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 6 (4 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn

#### GAUGE

19 sts x 28 rnds = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st) with larger ndl and using MC and CC held together as one

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

Knit using our smooth, supple Uptown Bamboo DK and playful Bella Pom Pom yarns held together, it's easy to make a statement with these quick and simple mittens!

These mittens are knit seamlessly in the round from the bottom up. The cuff features a twisted rib in the main color. The rest of the mittens use the main color and contrast color held together as one strand.

## STITCH GUIDE

### K1, P1 Twisted Rib

(even number of sts)

**Rnd 1:** \* K1 tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

## PATTERN BEGINS

### MITTENS

*Make 2 alike.*

#### Cuff

With smaller ndl and MC *only*, cast on 34 (38) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas 1½" from cast-on edge. Change to larger ndl.

#### Hand

Join CC with MC and hold both strands together as one.

**Rnds 1-7:** Knit.

#### Thumb Gusset

**Set-up Rnd:** K16 (18), pm, k2, pm, k16 (18).

**Rnd 1 (Inc Rnd):** Knit to m, sl m, m1L, knit to m, m1R, sl m, knit to end - 2 sts inc'd, 36 (40) sts.

**Rnds 2-3:** Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-3, 3 (4) more times, then rep Rnds 1-2, 1 more time - 8 (10) sts inc'd, 44 (50) sts.

#### Separate Thumb and Hand

**Next Rnd:** K16 (18), remove m, slip next 12 (14) sts to holder or waste yarn, remove m, cast on 2 sts using the backwards loop method, knit to end - 34 (38) sts.

#### Hand

Work even in St st until piece meas approx. 7½ (8)" from cast-on edge, or approx. ¼ (2¼)" less than desired length.



#### Shape Tip

**Set-up Rnd:** K17 (19), pm, k17 (19).

**Rnd 1 (Dec Rnd):** \* K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m; rep from \* to end - 4 sts dec'd, 30 (34) sts rem.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 5 (6) more times - 20 (24) sts dec'd, 10 sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** \* K1, S2KP2, k1; rep from \* one more time - 4 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem.

Break tail leaving approx. 8" tail. With MC *only*, thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close. Thread both tails to the inside of Mitten.

#### Thumb

With MC and CC held together as one and using larger ndl, pick up and knit 2 sts from cast-on edge, then pick up and knit 12 (14) held sts from holder or waste yarn. PM and join to knit in the rnd - 14 (16) sts.

Work in St st until Thumb meas 1¼ (2)" or ½" less than desired length.

**Next Rnd:** \* K2tog; rep from \* to end - 7 (8) sts dec'd, 7 (8) sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** Knit.

**Next Rnd:** K1 (0), \* k2tog; rep from \* to end - 3 (4) sts dec'd, 4 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving approx. 6" tail. With MC *only*, thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close. Thread both tails to the inside of Thumb.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements.  
Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

approx	approximately
CC	contrast color
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1R	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
MC	main color
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd	round
S2KP2	slip 2 stitches as if to knit 2 together, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches over knit stitch; centered double decreases
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
