# **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

## **SIZES**

About 30 x 34 in. (76 x 86.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® COVER STORY CHAINETTE (Art. #565)
  #201 Pink 5 balls
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

#### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Crochet hook size N/P-15 (10 mm)

#### GAUGE

1 ripple = about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) from peak to peak. EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.



# **NOTES**

- 1. Throw is worked back and forth in rows of a simple Ripple pattern.
- 2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating peaks and valleys. Peaks are formed by working 3 hdc in the same st. Valleys are formed by skipping 2 sts. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned.

## **THROW**

Ch 63.

Row 1: Work 2 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st), hdc in next 6 ch, sk next 2 ch, hdc in next 6 ch, \* 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 6 ch, sk next 2 ch, hdc in next 6 ch; rep from \* to last ch, 2 hdc in last ch – you will have 4 ripples in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working in back loops only, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, \* 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts; rep from \* to last st, 2 hdc in last st.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 34 in. (86.5 cm) from beginning or almost all yarn has been used. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

**ch** = chain

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

 $\mathbf{sk} = \mathbf{skip}$ 

st(s) = stitch(es)
