SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Shown in Small size with approx. 6" of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 36 $\frac{3}{4}$ (40, 43 $\frac{3}{4}$, 47 $\frac{3}{4}$, 52 $\frac{3}{4}$) (56, 59 $\frac{3}{4}$, 64 $\frac{1}{2}$, 68 $\frac{1}{4}$)"

Back Length from Shoulder: 22 $\frac{3}{4}$ (23, 23 $\frac{3}{4}$, 24 $\frac{1}{2}$, 25 $\frac{1}{4}$) (26 $\frac{1}{4}$, 27 $\frac{1}{2}$, 28 $\frac{1}{4}$, 28 $\frac{3}{4}$)"

Front Length from Shoulder: 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ (20 $\frac{3}{4}$, 21 $\frac{1}{2}$, 22 $\frac{1}{2}$, 23) (24, 25 $\frac{1}{4}$, 26, 26 $\frac{1}{2}$)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Fawning* (70% baby alpaca, 30% extra fine merino wool; 50g/164 yds)

- 104 Sesame – 7 (8, 9, 10, 11) (12, 13, 14, 15) balls

Needles:

Needle A: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 32-40" circular needle and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) or *size needed to obtain gauge*

Needle B: US Size 6 (4.5 mm) 16" and 32-40" circular and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

Needle C: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers (one unique marker to denote bor), stitch holders or waste yarn, removable stitch markers

GAUGE

21 sts x 30 rows/rnds = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st) with Ndl A, *after blocking*

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The Streamline Pullover elevates your everyday wardrobe. Garter stitch details lined with eyelets decorate the shoulders, front, back, and sleeves, bringing the classic stockinette stitches to life. The relaxed silhouette features a curved, high-low hem, roomy sleeves, and a funnel neck. It all comes together in our luxe yarn, Fawning. This cozy blend of baby alpaca and merino wool is an irresistible choice for autumn and winter, and you'll love knitting every stitch. You and your friends will be fawning over this delightful wardrobe staple!

This sweater is knit seamlessly from the top down. It begins with the back neck and stitches are increased to the fullest width, then worked evenly to the underarms where stitches are placed on hold. Then, stitches are picked up along the increased edge for the shoulders and worked flat, separately, to create the right and left fronts. Once the correct neck depth is achieved, the fronts are joined and worked even to the underarms. Then, the front and back are joined and worked in the round to the hem, which is shaped with short rows. Stitches for the sleeves are picked up from around the armhole and worked from the top down. Finally, stitches for the collar are picked up from around the neck and worked in the round.

STITCH GUIDE

Make Double Stitch

RS: Turn work so WS is facing. Sl 1 to right ndl wyif, pull working yarn tightly over ndl so it tugs up both legs of slipped st to look like two sts, (this is the "double stitch"). Bring yarn around back of ndl, then forward, passing between ndls so yarn is in front.

WS: Turn work so RS is facing. Sl 1 to right ndl wyif, pull working yarn tightly over ndl so it tugs up both legs of slipped st to look like two sts, (this is the "double stitch"). Bring yarn over ndl and leave it so yarn is in back.

Working the Double Stitch as Single Stitch

RS: Work to double stitch, work it as a single stitch by knitting both legs of double stitch together.

WS: Work to double stitch, work it as a single stitch by purling both legs of double stitch together.

PATTERN BEGINS

BACK

Shape Back Shoulders

With Ndl A, cast on 41 (41, 41, 43, 43) (43, 45, 45, 45) sts. Place removable markers into the cast on edge below the first and last stitch of the row.

Row 1 (RS): K4, pm, yo, k8, pm, yo, ssk, k13 (13, 13, 15, 15) (15, 17, 17, 17), k2tog, yo, pm, k8, yo, pm, k4 - 2 sts inc'd, 43 (43, 43, 45, 45) (45, 47, 47, 47) sts.

Row 2 (WS): P1, k3, sl m, yo, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, yo, sl m, k3, p1 - 2 sts inc'd, 45 (45, 45, 47, 47) (47, 49, 49, 49) sts.

Row 3: K4, sl m, yo, knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to m, yo, sl m, k4 - 2 sts inc'd, 47 (47, 47, 49, 49) (49, 51, 51, 51) sts.

Row 4: P1, k3, sl m, yo, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, yo, sl m, k3, p1 - 2 sts inc'd, 49 (49, 49, 51, 51) (51, 53, 53, 53) sts.

Rep Rows 3-4, 11 (14, 16, 18, 21) (24, 26, 29, 31) more times - 44 (56, 64, 72, 84) (96, 104, 116, 124) sts inc'd, 93 (105, 113, 123, 135) (147, 157, 169, 177) sts.

Sizes Extra Small, Medium, Large, 1X, & 5X ONLY:

Next Row (RS): K4, sl m, yo, knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to m, yo, sl m, k4 - 2 sts inc'd, 95 (x, 115, 125, 137) (x, x, x, 179) sts.

Place removable marker into the first and last stitch of the row.

Next Row (WS): P1, k3, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k3, p1.

Sizes Small, 2X, 3X, & 4X ONLY:

Place removable marker into the first and last stitch of the row.

ALL SIZES

95 (105, 115, 125, 137) (147, 157, 169, 179) sts.

Even Section

Row 1 (RS): K4, sl m, knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to m, sl m, k4.

Row 2 (WS): P1, k3, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k3, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas approx. 3 (2½, 2½, 2¼, 2¼) (2½, 2¾, 2¾, 2½)" from removable markers placed after the last increase row, ending with Row 2 of patt. Break yarn and place sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Left Front

With Ndl A, RS facing, and beginning at the left corner of the Back Neck cast-on, pick up and knit 27 (32, 37, 41, 47) (52, 56, 62, 67) sts along the left shoulder line (1 st for every row), turn work.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: Purl.

Shape Left Front Neck

Row 1 (RS): K3, m1L, knit to end - 1 st inc'd, 28 (33, 38, 42, 48) (53, 57, 63, 68) sts.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Rep Rows 1-2, 11 more times - 11 sts inc'd, 39 (44, 49, 53, 59) (64, 68, 74, 79) sts. Break yarn and place sts on holder or waste yarn.

Shape Right Front Neck

With Ndl A, RS facing, and beginning at the removable marker at the end of the increases on the Right Back Shoulder, pick up and knit 27 (32, 37, 41, 47) (52, 56, 62, 67) sts along the right shoulder line (1 st for every row), turn.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: Purl.

Shape Right Front Neck

Row 1 (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, m1R, knit to end - 1 st inc'd, 28 (33, 38, 42, 48) (53, 57, 63, 68) sts.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Rep Rows 1-2, 11 more times - 11 sts inc'd, 39 (44, 49, 53, 59) (64, 68, 74, 79) sts.

Join Right and Left Front

Row 1 (RS, Joining Row): Knit across 39 (44, 49, 53, 59) (64, 68, 74, 79) Right Front sts, pm, cast on 17 (17, 17, 19, 19) (19, 21, 21, 21) neck sts, pm, knit across 39 (44, 49, 53, 59) (64, 68, 74, 79) held Left Front sts, turn - 95 (105, 115, 125, 137) (147, 157, 169, 179) sts.

Row 2 (WS): Purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to end.

Row 3: Knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to end.

Rep Rows 2-3 until piece meas approx. 10¼ (11¼, 12¼, 13¼, 14¼) (16¼, 17¾, 19¼, 20½)" from picked-up edge (shoulder line), ending with Row 2.

Join Front and Back

Joining Row (RS): Cont in patt as est'd over 95 (105, 115, 125, 137) (147, 157, 169, 179) Front sts, pm for Side, cont in patt as est'd over 95 (105, 115, 125, 137) (147, 157, 169, 179) held Back sts, place unique marker and join to knit in the rnd - 190 (210, 230, 250, 274) (294, 314, 338, 358) sts.

Rnd 1: Knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to Side m, sl m, k1, p3, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, p3, k1.

Rnd 2: Knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to Side m, sl m, k4, sl m, knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to m, sl m, k4.

Rep Rnds 1-2 until piece meas approx. 11 (11, 11, 11½, 11½) (11½, 12, 12, 12)" from underarms, ending with Rnd 2.

Shape Hem with Short Rows

Note: You will now begin working flat. Continue working pattern as established throughout short row shaping.

Set-up Row (RS): K32 (35, 38, 42, 46) (49, 54, 56, 60), make double stitch.

Short Row 1 (WS): Purl to bor m, sl m, cont in patt as est'd to Side m, sl m, p32 (35, 38, 42, 46) (49, 54, 56, 60), make double stitch.

Short Row 2: Cont in patt as est'd to 7 (8, 9, 9, 10) (11, 12, 13, 14) sts bef double stitch, make double stitch.

Short Rows 3-15: Rep Short Row 2.

Short Row 16: Cont in patt as est'd to bor m, working each double stitch as a single stitch.

You will now resume working in the rnd.

Next Rnd: Cont in patt as est'd to end, working each double stitch as a single stitch.

Hem

Change to 32-40" circ Ndl B. Place a removable marker into the fabric.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnds 1-2, 2 times.

Rnd 7: Knit.

Rnd 8: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 7-8 until piece meas approx. 3" from the removable marker.

Bind off all sts in patt.

SLEEVES

Make two alike.

With Ndl A for small circumferences in the rnd, RS facing, and beginning at the center of the underarm, pick up and knit 70 (72, 78, 82, 90) (100, 108, 116, 120) sts evenly around armhole.

Rnd 1: K2, pm, k3, k2tog, yo, pm, knit to last 7 sts, pm, yo, ssk, k3, pm, k2.

Rnd 2: K2, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k2.

Rnd 3: K2, sl m, k3, k2tog, yo, sl m, knit to m, sl m, yo, ssk, k3, sl m, k2.

Rep Rnds 2-3 until Sleeve meas approx. 11¼ (11½, 11¾, 10¾, 9¾) (7¾, 6¾, 5¾, 4¾)" from picked-up edge, ending with Rnd 2.

Shape Sleeve

Dec Rnd: K2, sl m, k3, k2tog, yo, sl m, k1, k2tog, knit to 3 sts bef m, ssk, k1, sl m, yo, ssk, k3, sl m, k2 - 2 sts dec'd, 68 (70, 76, 80, 88) (98, 106, 114, 118) sts rem.

Even Rnd: K2, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k2.

Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd, 11 (12, 13, 15, 17) (22, 24, 28, 30) more times - 22 (24, 26, 30, 34) (44, 48, 56, 60) sts dec'd, 46 (46, 50, 50, 54) (54, 58, 58, 58) sts rem.

Cuff

Change to Ndl B for small circumferences.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnds 1-2, 2 times.

Rnd 7: Knit.

Rnd 8: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 7-8 until Sleeve meas approx. 18 (18, 18, 18, 17) (17, 16½, 16½, 15½)" from picked-up edge.

Bind off all sts in patt.

Collar

With Ndl B 16" circ ndl, RS facing, and beginning at the upper right back neck, pick up and knit 98 (98, 98, 102, 102) (102, 106, 106, 106) sts evenly around the neck opening. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-2 until Collar meas approx. 2¾" from picked-up edge.

Change to Ndl C 16" circ ndl.

Rep Rnds 1-2 until Collar meas approx. 4½" from picked-up edge. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
